Annual Law Enforcement Scholarship

Qualifications

1. Applicants must be one of the following and be under the age of 25:
 - a. A graduate of a Pearland High School or a high school senior who is a resident of Pearland or a resident within the City of Pearland's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction currently enrolled in an undergraduate Criminal Justice Program at an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy.
 - b. A dependent of a Pearland Police Department employee, who is a high school graduate enrolled in undergraduate studies in an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy or high school senior enrolling in undergraduate studies in an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy.
 - c. A member of Law Enforcement Explorer Post 237 currently enrolled in an undergraduate Criminal Justice Program at an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy or who is a high school senior enrolling in an undergraduate Criminal Justice Program in an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy.
 - d. A member of the Pearland Citizens Police Academy Alumni Association or Pearland Teen Citizen academy graduate who is in good standing, who is a high school graduate enrolled in an undergraduate Criminal Justice Program at an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy, or a high school senior enrolling in an undergraduate Criminal Justice Program at an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy.

- e. A dependent of a Pearland Citizens Police Academy Alumni Association member who is in good standing, who is a high school graduate enrolled in an undergraduate Criminal Justice Program at an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy or who is in good standing, who is a high school senior enrolling in an undergraduate Criminal Justice Program at an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy.
 - f. A dependent of a City of Pearland employee, who is a high school graduate enrolled in an undergraduate Criminal Justice Program at an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy or who is a high school senior enrolling in an undergraduate Criminal Justice Program at an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy.
2. Applicants must submit the following before the August 2nd, 2019 deadline:
- a. A completed Scholarship Application Form.
 - b. A letter of acceptance from the college, university, or regional law enforcement academy. (Or college transcripts if already attending)
 - c. High School Transcript (2.0 GPA Minimum)
 - d. College Transcripts (if applicable) (2.0 GPA Minimum)
 - e. A full-faced photograph attached to an 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper.
 - f. A short essay between 300 - 600 words on one of the following topics:
 - i. Police Community Relations
 - ii. Law Enforcement's Role in Society
 - iii. Police Professionalism
 - iv. The Law Enforcement Code of Ethics
 - v. The Effects of a Police Career on Family
3. Application Deadlines are August 2nd 2019, prior to the academic year (starting in the Fall semester) for which the application is submitted.
- a. Scholarships are awarded in the amount of \$1000 or 500.00 for the academic year.
 - b. Applicants must have attended the spring semester prior to application or show proof of completed registration for the upcoming fall semester.
 - c. Applicants are eligible to re-apply for college or university program scholarships. Applicants may be awarded up to four scholarships in a maximum of four years.
